

# Programming Policies

## Regular Session 2021-22

The RWB School has implemented new policies relating to the current COVID-19 pandemic and its effects.

### Dance Instruction

The RWB School will deliver dance programming during the 2021-22 Regular Session. We intend to offer our dance programs in-studio.

Due to social distancing restrictions, the RWB School reserves the right to deliver programming on a rotating schedule. In such instances, students will attend in-studio or online classes in rotation until such time as all students are permitted in-studio.

Should all in-studio programming be suspended at any time during the 2021-22 Regular Session due to government regulations or a required RWB building closure, dance instruction will continue as distance learning via Zoom. The RWB School will make every reasonable effort to minimize disruption to existing class schedules.

### Tuition Rebates

Should all in-studio programming be suspended at any time during the 2021-22 Regular Session and the RWB School is required to deliver classes via distance learning for more than **3 consecutive weeks**, students may be eligible for a partial tuition rebate. Rebates will be offered to eligible students for 30% of tuition fees pertaining to the distance learning period, from the beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive week, onward. All non-refundable ancillary fees are excluded from tuition rebate calculations.

Partial tuition rebates will be calculated **from the beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive week of distance learning** as follows:  
**(Tuition fees / # of weeks per session) x (# of weeks of distance learning – first 3 weeks of distance learning) x 30%**

*Example:*

*(\$1,000 tuition fees / 10-week session) x (4 weeks of distance learning – first 3 weeks of distance learning) x 30%*

*Therefore: (\$1,000 / 10) x (4-3) x 30% = \$30 rebate*

**In-studio suspension periods of 3 or fewer consecutive weeks resulting in distance learning do not qualify for a rebate. Rotational programming periods where in-studio participation is permitted, though limited to smaller in-studio groupings do not qualify for a rebate.** During the 2021-22 Regular Session, the RWB School will monitor in-studio class suspensions resulting in periods of distance learning. If rebates are determined to be due, they will be calculated and processed in June 2022 after the completion of the 2021-22 Regular Session term. Rebate summaries outlining affected classes will be provided to students who qualify. Students will be asked to confirm or update payment information prior to being issued a rebate.

### **Not Eligible For Tuition Rebate**

Students may not be eligible for a rebate if they have an account balance owing, received scholarships, financial assistance, paid specialized tuition prices including specialized boys' fees, or whose programmed classes were scheduled to end prior to an in-studio suspension period.

Classes from which students have voluntarily withdrawn during the 2021-22 Regular Session are not eligible for a rebate.

Classes that students have not attended during the 2021-22 Regular Session for any reason, including illness or scheduling conflicts are not eligible for a tuition rebate.

Classes not running due to statutory holidays during the 2021-22 Regular Session are not eligible for a tuition rebate

### Make-up and Drop-In Classes

The RWB School has made the decision to suspend both make-up and drop-in classes until further notice. To ensure student safety and until such as time as social distancing measures, government regulations, and safety protocols are no longer at issue, make-up and drop-in classes will not be permitted.

The RWB School reserves the right to reverse this decision should these class options become feasible in the future, at which time students will be notified.
