

COVID-19 & Other Public Health Programming Policies

Regular Session 2024-25



The RWB School will deliver in-person dance programming during Regular Session 2024-25. Online programming will only be offered if COVID-19 or other Public Health restrictions/policies make it impossible for students to attend Regular Session 2024-25 in person.

Due to evolving COVID-19 policies, the RWB School reserves the right to modify programming. Changes or modifications to programming may include but are not limited to the cancellation of specific classes or adjustments to class times and duration.

Should in-studio classes be suspended at any time during Regular Session 2024-25 (September 8, 2024 – May 31, 2025) due to government regulations or a required RWB building closure, in-studio dance instruction will continue as distance learning via an online delivery method. The RWB School will make every reasonable effort to minimize disruption to existing programming.

Tuition Rebates

Should in-studio programming be suspended at any time during the 2024-25 Regular Session and the RWB School is required to deliver classes via distance learning for more than **3 consecutive weeks**, students may be eligible for a partial tuition rebate. Rebates will be offered to eligible students for 30% of tuition fees pertaining to the distance learning period, from the beginning of the 4th consecutive week, onward. All non-refundable ancillary fees are excluded from tuition rebate calculations.

Partial tuition rebates will be calculated **from the beginning of the 4th consecutive week of distance learning** as follows: **(Tuition fees / # of weeks per session) x (# of weeks of distance learning – first 3 weeks of distance learning) x 30%**

Example: (\$649 tuition fees / 34-week session) x (4 weeks of distance learning – first 3 weeks of distance learning) x 30%. Therefore: (\$649 / 34) x (4-3) x 30% = \$5.73 rebate

In-studio suspension periods of 3 or fewer consecutive weeks resulting in distance learning do not qualify for a rebate. Rotational programming periods where in-studio participation is permitted, though limited to smaller in-studio groupings do not qualify for a rebate. During the 2024-25 Regular Session, the RWB School will monitor in-studio class suspensions resulting in periods of distance learning. If rebates are determined to be due, they will be calculated and processed in June 2025 after the completion of the 2024-25 Regular Session term. Rebate summaries outlining affected classes will be provided to students who qualify. Students will be asked to confirm or update payment information prior to being issued a rebate.

Not Eligible for Tuition Rebate

Students may not be eligible for a rebate if they have an account balance owing, received scholarships, financial assistance, paid specialized tuition prices or whose programmed classes were scheduled to end prior to an in-studio suspension period.

Classes from which students have voluntarily withdrawn during the 2024-25 Regular Session are not eligible for a rebate.

Classes that students have not attended during the 2024-25 Regular Session for any reason, including illness, injury, or scheduling conflicts, are not eligible for a tuition rebate.

Classes not running due to statutory holidays during the 2024-25 Regular Session are not eligible for a tuition rebate.
