



**Henning Albrechtsen**

Freelance/Guest Teacher

In 1985 Henning Albrechtsen was engaged as dancer at the Royal Danish Ballet. Since 1997 he has been a teacher at RDBS and now 2015, he also freelance teaches internationally.

Henning Albrechtsen has in the period from 1985 - 2000 danced a vast variety of soloist and principal parts in classical as well as in neo-classical repertoire – from Bournonville to Balanchine.

Promoted to Deputy Artistic Director of the Royal Danish Ballet in 2000.

In 2007 enrolled at the Teachers Training Programme for former professional dancers at the National Ballet School of Canada and completed the one year educational programme and was invited back to the Royal Danish Ballet school as a full time teacher in 2008.

Henning Albrechtsen has taught Master classes at various ballet schools around the world. These schools consist of The Royal Ballet School in London, Paris Opera Ballet School, National Ballet School of Cuba and the National Ballet School of Canada. Furthermore he has taught classical ballet, pas de deux classes and the Bournonville technique and also, given teachers seminars in the USA, Australia, Japan, Mexico, Sweden, Norway and Spain.
