



RD Registration Process – Frequently Asked Questions

When and where is registration?

Registration will run from **June 20 – 28, 2018**. Registration will take place at the Royal Winnipeg Ballet School (380 Graham Avenue) on the 2nd floor atrium.

How do I access the appointments?

Returning Parents/Students can visit www.rwb.org/register on **May 8, 2018 at 10:00 am**. Simply click on the "Register Now" button, which will take you to the appointment booking page.

New students can be registering on **May 22, 2018 at 10:00 am**. Simply click on the "Register Now" button, which will take you to the appointment booking page.

What if I can't get the appointment I want? What if the website isn't loading? HELP!

Once the appointments become live, there should be no problem accessing the website. There are guaranteed appointments for all current RD students. School Interviews works best from a personal computer or laptop. If issues do arise, contact the School Office for assistance.

Is someone at the School Office able to schedule my appointment for me?

Unfortunately, the School Office cannot make appointments for families.

Do I need my child's class placement in order to book an appointment?

No, you do not need your child's placement level to book an appointment. However, all current RD students are required to bring their placement with them to registration.

Does each student in my family need his /her own appointment?

Each student per family is required to book an individual appointment slot. Families with 4 or more students are only required to book 4 appointments – we are confident that we can register all of the students in those families within that time. We encourage families to book consecutive appointments.

What if one sibling is a current RD student but another sibling is a new student to the RWB?

Families can book both appointments to occur during the returning student registration period.

How can I make my registration appointment go more quickly?

Registration forms are available online in fillable PDF format at www.rwb.org/register. Bringing completed forms to your registration appointment will save you time. Our class schedule will also be available online to help you organize your dance class schedule in advance of your appointment.

What if the class for which I want to register is full? How will I know?

We encourage families to book the earliest possible appointment in order to secure a spot in their preferred class. We will do our best to post updates to class availability online, however the most up-to-date information will be available in person at registration.

Classes are available on a first come, first served basis and are all subject to availability. The RWB School has an excellent waitlist system in place for popular classes; however your name on the waitlist does not guarantee a spot in the class.

What if I cannot be present to register my child? Can another family member register for me?

A person other than the designated primary caregiver may register a student, as long as the paperwork is completed in full and the registration authorization portion is completed on Appendix A. The adult present must also have adequate payment for each student. Without this information, the RWB School is unable to complete the registration process.

What if I can't make it to the June registration? When can I register?

Returning Students: May register during regular School Office hours throughout the summer months. An appointment will not be necessary during this time, but the student's placement will be required at the time of registration. Class availability may be limited after the official registration period.

New students: May also register throughout the summer; however artistic support may be required. They should complete an Appendix D (Dance Background) form if they have previous dance experience. An artistic staff person will review this form within one business week and will follow up with correct class placement and instructions on how to complete the registration process. A student without previous dance experience may be able to register without artistic support.

What is the average cost to enroll myself or my child in dance?

- RWB School students enjoy 35 weeks of programming (that's like three and a half 10-week sessions!) For our littlest dancers, that works out to just \$11 per class!
- We offer payment plans as well as multi-class family discounts.
- We offer highly subsidized pricing for boys ages 3-15 – only \$100 for the full year September through June!
- Wardrobe for end-of-year recitals is included with your tuition so no surprise costume fees at the end of the school year!
- Discounted downtown parking is available during classes and students enjoy discounts on RWB tickets!
