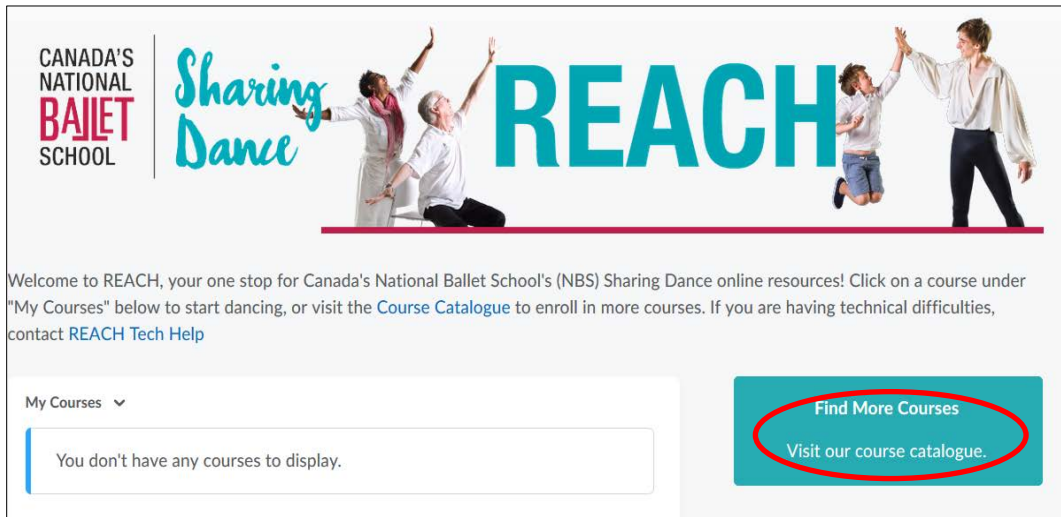

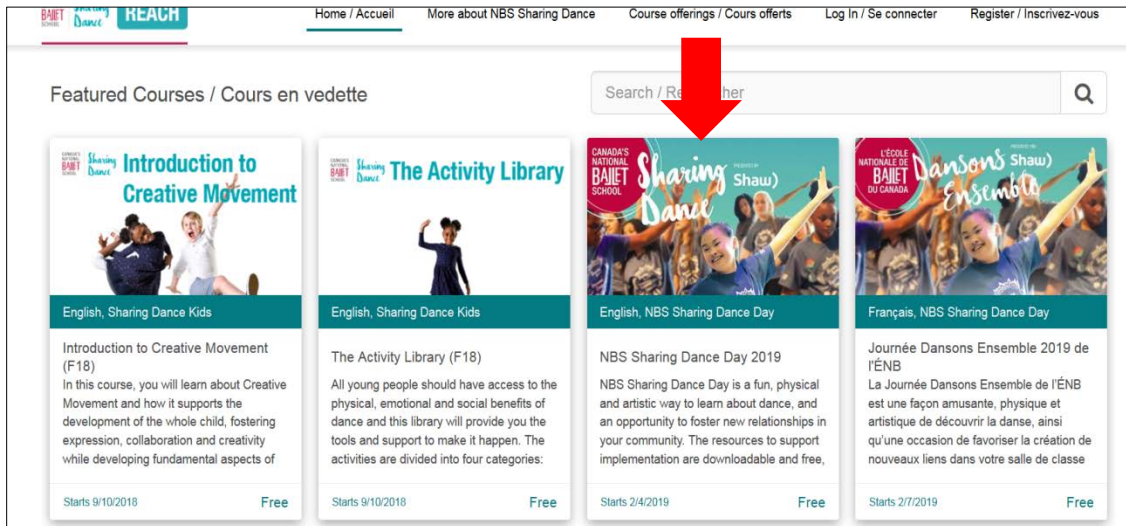

1. After creating an account and logging into your account, you will see NBS Sharing Dance REACH Homepage.
