



Craig Ramsay was born and raised near Windsor, Ontario, Canada. Immediately after graduating, Craig performed at the Banff Centre for the Arts in their co-production with the Houston Grand Opera “Jackie O”. It was during this time where Craig was introduced to ballet and was taught by Canadian legends Brian Macdonald and Annette Av Paul.

Shortly after, Craig auditioned at the age 20 for the Royal Winnipeg Ballet School’s Professional Division.

During his time at the RWB, Craig was mentored by the late great Arnold Spohr. That relationship, and the artistic influence of Evelyn Hart, inspired not only his dancing but also his acting and performing career onstage, in film, and TV.

Craig’s professional career started at the Charlottetown Festival where he performed the role of Willy Boulter in Canada’s beloved musical “Anne of Green Gables”. It was the original Canadian cast of the megahit musical “Mamma Mia” that brought Craig into the United States where he performed on Broadway in the musical “Fiddler on the Roof”, directed by David Leveaux, and shared the stage with Alfred Molina, Andrea Martin, Harvey Fierstein, Lea Michelle, and Rosie O’Donnell. Other Broadway/off Broadway and regional

highlights include: original Broadway cast of “Chitty Chitty Bang Bang”, choreographed by Gillian Lynne, “On the 20th Century”, playing opposite Jo Anne Worley, “Hair” with Jennifer Hudson and RuPaul, Rocky in “Rocky Horror Picture Show” with NBC Universal, and Rum Tum Tugger in “Cats”. Craig was also in the original cast of Stephen Sondheim and Hal Prince’s “Bounce” the musical with MGM treasure Jane Powell.

Craig acted alongside John Hurt, Cynthia Nixon, Denis O’Hare, and Swoosie Kurtz in the film “An Englishman in New York”. Craig danced & acted with Carol Burnett and Tracey Ullman in “Once Upon a Mattress” and regularly appeared on “All My Children” and “General Hospital”, as well as guest starring on CBS’s “2 Broke Girls” and “The Graham Norton Show”.

Reality TV fame gave Craig worldwide recognition having starred and appeared in the Bravo TV shows “Thintervention”, “Newlyweds: The First Year”, and most recently “Shahs of Sunset”.
